Your child's class will visit the school library weekly to select books. You can help your child by reading to or with him/her and asking questions about the story. Encourage your child to spend time reading at home every day. Children are responsible for handling library books with care, since they are for everyone to share. Please keep books away from pets, foods and all liquids.

Any damage to books should be reported to the class teacher as soon as possible. Library books may be kept for one week then must be returned. A book may be renewed (checked out again) if the child has not finished reading it. An overdue (late) book means a child cannot borrow another book (until overdue book is renewed or returned). If a book is damaged, payment toward a replacement will be requested from the parents.

We hope your child will read and enjoy many books and grow to love reading while attending our school.
